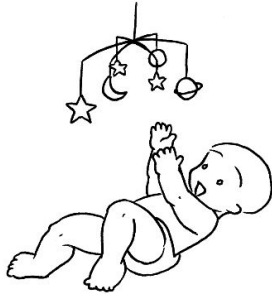


# Pictures and Mobiles

Age: Infants (0-8 months)

This activity helps your child's development in this domain: Language and Literacy

## What You Need:



- Pictures or posters to hang on the wall
- A mobile for your baby's crib

## What To Do:

1. Place pictures or posters on the wall next to your baby's crib or bed, or hang a mobile over the crib but out of your baby's reach.
2. Point to things in the poster or mobile and talk about them. For example, "Look at the rainbow. There are so many colors. I see red, yellow, and blue."
3. Blow on the mobile to make it move and watch your baby's reaction. Talk about what happens.
4. Change posters every now and then so he has different things to look at.

**Safety Alert:** Keep mobiles out of your baby's reach to prevent him from getting tangled in the cords or pulling off small objects that could cause choking when swallowed.
