What To Do:

1. Show your child how to act out the words of the poem written below.
2. Repeat the words and actions so he can learn them.

I have two eyes to see with. (Touch your eyes.)

I have two feet to run. (Run in place.)

I have two hands to wave with. (Wave both hands.)

But a nose, I have but one. (Touch your nose.)

I have two ears to hear with. (Touch your ears.)

And a tongue to say "hello." (Point to your tongue.)

And two cheeks for you to pinch. (Gently pinch your cheeks.)

And now it's time to go. (Run around the room.)
