

Paper Plate Umbrella

Age: Toddlers (18-36 months)

This activity helps your child's development in this domain: Language and Literacy

What You Need:



- A large paper plate
- A pencil or chopstick
- Jumbo crayons or washable markers

What To Do:

1. Using a pencil or chopstick, poke a hole in the middle of a large paper plate.
2. ask your child to decorate the backside of the plate with crayons or markers
3. Have your child stick his pointing finger through the hole and pretend that he has an umbrella.
4. Next, sing a song together:

It's raining, it's raining.

Oh me, oh my!

But our umbrellas will keep us dry!



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
